1. In August 2011 the Government attempted to stimulate school sport by introducing the role of the Competition Manager. Assess the potential impact of this on physical activity in schools and the wider development structures at community level.

2. Commenting on the concept of sport at community level Fred Coalter in his report from (2005) *The Social Benefit of Sport* wrote;

"Sport is not a homogeneous, standardised product or experience – the nature of the experience will be subject to wide variations, as will the effects."

Assess the challenges that this statement might raise for community based sport and active leisure delivery.
