Crime & Criminal Justice

On the criminal justice course, you will embrace critical thinking to investigate individual, social, legal and political forces that shape crime and how it is controlled. Theory is supported by practice in crime causation, criminal behaviours and how to combat crime.

You will be encouraged to develop skills such as critical reasoning, analytical ability, problem-solving, theoretical and conceptual thought and the application of theory to real situations.

Academics with criminal justice backgrounds encourage you to develop practical skills, including the personal qualities of resilience and determination, needed to work in this dynamic sector.

The LL.B (Hons) Law degree prepares you for practice in the legal profession as a solicitor or barrister. The qualification is highly regarded by employers and is the basis for graduate-level entry into other careers such as commerce, industry, civil service and the armed forces.

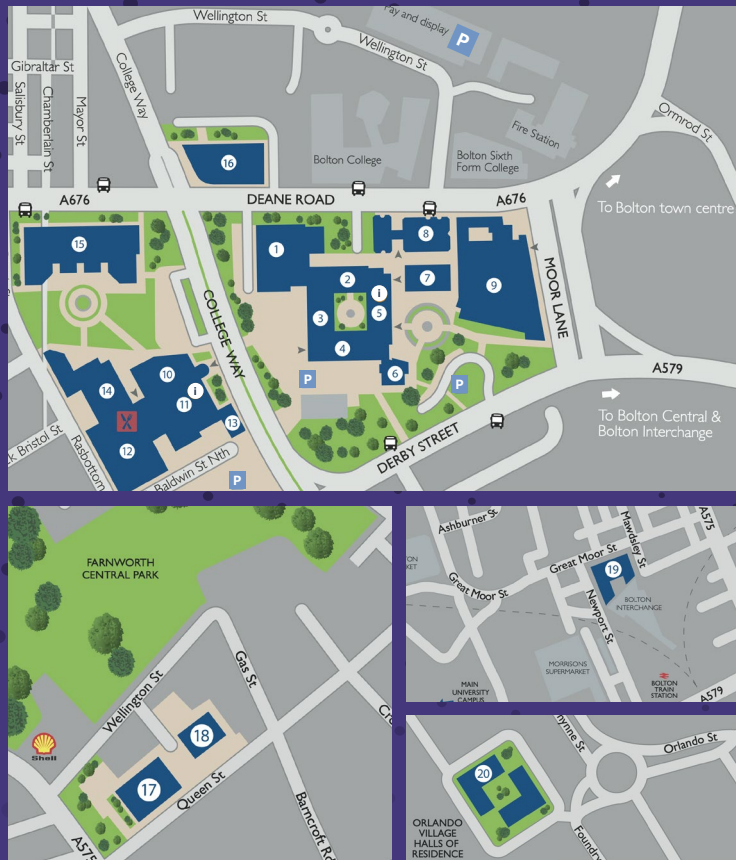
