

Bolton Master's Bursary 2020

The *Bolton Master's Bursary 2020* is designed to reward those students who join the University of Bolton for a Master's programme in September 2020.

Amount

This award is a cashless bursary and will be paid as a £1,000 top-up on a successful students' #UniAsItShouldBe card.

Eligibility

1. This award is available to all Home and EU students joining the University in September 2020. This award is not available for International students, however, the International Excellence Scholarship Programme is available.
2. This award is available to full and part-time 180 credit Master's degrees. It is not available for any partial Master's courses or any other postgraduate courses including PGCE or Cert Ed courses. Please see the terms and conditions for a list of excluded courses.
3. The Master's course must be studied On-Campus at the University of Bolton and not at a franchise partner location.
4. This award is available only for Master's courses commencing in September 2020 and no other intakes.
5. Graduates must meet the normal entry requirements for the Master's programme including the usual pre-requisite degree course.

Payment

This award will be paid as a £1,000 addition to qualifying students' #UniAsItShouldBe card subject to continuing eligibility.

This award will be paid in two instalments:

- The first payment of £500 paid on to the #UniAsItShouldBe card will be made once enrolment is completed
- The second payment of £500 paid on to the #UniAsItShouldBe card will be paid once the first instalment of tuition fees (1/3 of fees) are received by the University

- This award is NOT available in conjunction with the Alumni Loyalty Discount
- The following courses are excluded from the scheme:
 - MSc Physician Associates
 - All ITT/PGCE courses
 - MA Social Work
 - MSc Physiotherapy
 - MSc Advanced Clinical Practice
 - MSc Clinical Practice
 - MBA Global Medical Leadership
- This scholarship is made entirely at the discretion of the University
