

## **GRADUATION PRIVACY NOTICE**

The University of Bolton's graduation ceremonies are significant events for our graduates, their guests and our staff. These ceremonies are public events with official photography taken and live coverage broadcast on campus and online and therefore there is no expectation of privacy under data protection legislation for any attendees. This privacy notice explains how the University will process personal data for and during the event.

This privacy notice applies to all graduating students at the University of Bolton who are intending to graduate or may be eligible for an award, whether they attend a ceremony or not, invited guests and staff. Please note the following important information and ensure that your guests are also aware of the information relevant to them:

## **Graduation Ceremony Programme**

• Your student name will be listed underneath your award title and subject within the graduation ceremony programme published by the University. The programme is distributed to all those who attend on the day of graduation.

## **During the Graduation Ceremony**

- If you graduate in person your name and award title will be read out at the ceremony immediately prior to you walking across the stage
- Your photograph will be taken at the point that you receive your 'scroll' and shake the hand of the Presiding Officer.
- The University's official photographer(s) that include William Northam will take generic crowd shots (which may include you and your guests) at all venues and graduation receptions.
- For individual or smaller group shots off stage the photographer will seek your consent before taking the photograph. You should advise the photographer before any photograph is taken if you do not wish to be photographed.
- All ceremonies are live streamed to the University website, on screens around campus and ceremony venue, and via social media at the time of the ceremony.
- Television companies may be present to interview our honorary graduands and other VIPs or to film the event generally. If you do not wish to appear on television, you should maintain your distance from any filming that may take place.
- Live stream recordings and photographs of these events may be used to market and promote the activities of the University of Bolton and these may appear in any of our promotional materials, in printed or electronic format, including the University website, press, social media, multimedia productions, course leaflets or prospectuses.
- Information relating to disability, access needs and special arrangements will only
  be used to make reasonable adjustments at the ceremonies. The University may,
  if necessary, appoint a specialist to ensure that students and/or guests requiring
  alternative arrangements receive tailored support. We will discuss your
  requirements with you upon receiving a request and if necessary, with your consent,
  we may share information with the appointed specialist on the day of your ceremony

so that they are able to support you as necessary. This information will not be shared with any other department within the University and will be deleted from our records after the graduation ceremonies.

 All personal data will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and UK General Data Protection Regulation.
